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List and Guidelines for Allocation of Open Elective (OE) Courses under NEP 2020

Guidelines for Allocation of Open Elective (OE) Courses

Open Elective (OE) Courses are courses which are to be chosen by the students from an unrelated discipline/ subject, with an intention to seek exposure beyond discipline/s of choice.

The purpose of Open Elective (OE) Courses is to offer the students the option to explore disciplines of interest beyond the choices they make in core and discipline specific elective courses.

Hence, the students should be **encouraged to opt for Open Elective (OE) Courses from other streams / faculties**. For example, the students of Commerce discipline should opt for Open Elective (OE) Courses of Science / Arts streams.

In any case, **no student should be allowed to opt for an Open Elective (OE) Course from the Core Discipline / Disciplines selected by him/her for the undergraduate Program**. For example, if a student has chosen Sociology and Political Science as Core Disciplines then he/she should not be allowed to opt for the Open Elective (OE) Courses offered by the Departments of Sociology and Political Science.

Similarly, teachers from one discipline should not be allowed to teach the Open Elective (OE) Courses of another discipline. For example, the teachers of Commerce should not be allowed to teach the Open Elective (OE) Courses of Business Administration and vice versa.

In order to facilitate the proper process of allocation of Open Elective (OE) Courses, the Colleges should make arrangements to provide proper orientation and guidance to the students regarding the concept of Open Elective (OE) Courses as explained above; should display the list of Open Elective (OE) Courses available for selection by the students in their respective colleges and guide their students to make an informed selection of Open Elective (OE) Course.
